

# Texas Child Health Access Through Telemedicine

## Guide for PCPs and Pediatric Providers

### **What is TCHATT?**

TCHATT is a free short term telemedicine program between BCM and southeastern Texas school districts to help identify and assess the behavioral health needs of children & adolescents.

- **WE ARE OPEN DURING THE SUMMER!**
- *A TCHATT referral can only be sent in by a **school counselor**, and not by a pediatrician or PCP.*

### **How to use TCHATT**

1. Identify a child who could benefit from TCHATT services.
2. Determine if child attends school in BCM catchment area.
3. If student attends a TCHATT school, provide family with TCHATT flyer and ask them to reach out to school counselor to initiate a TCHATT referral.
